# Apprenticeship Program Update

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## The Importance of the Stepping Stones Program

Regarding the Apprenticeship Program, all three programs will begin scheduling interviews with the 32 candidates starting next week. Of these, four candidates from our Union have advanced to the interview stage. It is crucial for our membership to enroll in the Stepping Stones Program that prepares them for the aptitude test. Our members have demonstrated a need for improvement in specific test areas, resulting in scores that fall short of making the top ten cut.

The Union has reviewed the test results and believes we can better equip our members with the necessary tools before they take the test. The Union is committed to intensively promoting the existing pro-

gram to ensure our members are well-prepared for the next round of in-person interviews offered by the Apprenticeship Program, which we anticipate will occur either this year or next.
